RoundTowner Membership Conduct Policy

The purpose of this policy is to outline the expectations and standards of proper conduct expected of all RoundTowner members when engaged in volunteer activities sanctioned by the RoundTowners organization. Proper conduct is necessary in order to preserve the professionalism and integrity of the organization and to assure our reputation of courteous and dedicated service to the public.

It is the responsibility of each RoundTowner to read, understand, and agree to the code of conduct as outlined below.

Proper Conduct:

- Understand and believe in the mission of the RoundTowner's organization.
- Fulfill any agreement to volunteer at an event, or at a minimum, find a replacement and contact the appropriate Volunteer Coordinator.
- Promptly attend and begin agreed upon shift on time and remain on station until released by Event Official.
- Treat Officials, fellow volunteers, customers, and other participants with respect and dignity.
- Work safely and professionally during a shift.
- Represent the RoundTowners in a positive and respectful manner.
- Adhere to all guidelines set by Event Producers and Officials.

When working a shift, RoundTowners will not:

- Consume alcoholic beverages/food while working a shift and/or while wearing a volunteer shirt, except where approved by Event Officials.
- Take or give away any cash/tickets/tokens, food, beverage, except where approved by Event Officials.
- Wear inappropriate attire as identified by the Event Officials, Volunteer Coordinator, or Shift Captains.
- Use abusive and/or derogatory verbal or body language.

PRIVACY: WE DO NOT share RoundTowners personal information (telephone, address, email) outside of the RoundTowners.
